Targeted Event: Outside Group reserves the space for an event specifically for minors (e.g. High School or Club awards ceremony, Boy Scout Meeting, Academic class for high school students, One-on-One music lessons, etc.) Individuals working on behalf of the Outside Group (Group staff and volunteers) must complete a background check. Private Event: Family reserves space at the Bone for a family wedding. Minors will attend the event. If Outside Group hires a babysitter to watch children, a background check of the babysitter would be required. If parents (and/or individuals designated by the parent) are supervising the children during the Event, those children would be considered chaperoned.	NO
Independent RSO holds tutoring sessions in Schroeder Hall for junior high students. All ISU students who will serve as tutors must complete a background check.	YES
ISU Housing: Outside Group reserves University Housing rooms for private camp over the summer. Teenage summer camp participants will reside in the dormitory under the supervision of Outside Group staff. All Outside Group staff must complete a background check.	YES
